President's Report- Page

Lake Champlain Access Television Corporation (Channel 2) is the community access (PEG) television provider for Colchester, Georgia, and Milton. Additionally, a small number of North Burlington viewers receive our programming. The total potential viewing audience is between 8,000–9,000 Adelphia cable television subscribers in our viewing area, and this audience continues to increase in number as residential neighborhoods are created in each of the communities we serve. Administrative and Operating costs for Channel 2 are fully subsidized by a contribution provided, by law, from Adelphia Cable Corporation – Vermont's largest commercial television service provider.

Channel 2 provides live and taped programs for viewers, and some of our locally produced programs are relayed (fed) into Vermont's network of community access television stations for viewing in other regions statewide. Channel 2 provides live and taped gavel-to-gavel coverage of public community meetings, including all Select Board and several other governmental meetings in the communities we serve. Additionally, Channel 2 staff and volunteer producers offer a range of public interest programs such as our award-winning Story **Time** for children and families, popular programs focussing on the contributions of women in Colchester, gardening (Michelle Penca's award-winning Vermont Gardens), and local political issues. Community government leaders discuss and describe various aspects of their work and programs. A new program, Community Round **Table**, provides a weekly discussion and telephone call-in forum about civic, commercial development and enterprise, governmental, and social issues as well as other topics which, hopefully, are of interest to local viewers.

The year leading up to Y2K has been arduous, challenging, frustrating, encouraging and eventful for Lake Champlain Access Cable Television. 1999 has been a year of and for change, and the Board of Directors and our capable staff have engaged the demands for change with sadness, competence, and excitement.

In 1999, Channel 2 lost our long-term mentor, board member, program producer and friend, Jim McMullan to cancer. Jim has been a veritable spark plug and the "infield utility" person for Lake Champlain Access Television from the beginning. The offices and roles he filled over the years, the tasks he performed, the community contacts he made, the volunteer recruiting he was able to do, his behind-the-camera work – all contributed to the success of Channel 2 from the station's infancy to the present. He will be missed for years to come. In Jim's memory, and to remind us daily of his many contributions and the presence he commanded, our studio bears a plaque dedicating the facility to him.

President's Report- Page

With the capable and competent work of our Executive Director, Jess Wilson, we entered contract negotiations with Adelphia Cable – negotiations which continue as this report is prepared. Highlights of the new contract, when approved by Adelphia Cable Corporation, include a significant increase in the Adelphia contribution for our continued operations; the proposed addition of a second channel for our corporation so we can more adequately meet the increasing demand for more and better programming; and a substantial increase in the number of municipal television "connecting points" so that we can broadcast more events, live from more sites in Colchester, Georgia, and Milton.

Regrettably, your Board accepted Jess's resignation as we encouraged her to assume her new position with added responsibility at our sibling Burlington station, Channel 17. During her tenure as Channel Director, Jess organized and implemented necessary administrative and operating protocols designed to guarantee management and operational success for Channel 2. She led our contract negotiation efforts, and assertively guided the relatively new Board of Directors as negotiations floundered in our advocacy to improve our budget and expand our broadcast "foot print" with the proposed additional community connections and second channel for 2001. Jess guided the Board in a difficult and successful negotiation and legal struggle seeking a return of funds to the corporation from a former board member.

In November, Kevin Christopher became the Channel Director by a unanimous vote of the Board. Kevin worked with and was supervised by Jess Wilson throughout 1998 and 1999. His willingness to move into the Channel Director's position affected a clear, easy transition for Channel 2. The Board commends Kevin for his continued commitment, especially as stalled contract negotiations appear to be moving to a new, more political level with the Board's decision to involve the Vermont Public Service Board and our corporate attorney to bring negotiations to a successful end.

In closing, while 1999 was a year filled with challenges for Channel 2 and a year in which we experienced the losses of a highly respected volunteer leader as well as our station director, 1999 has also been a year of exciting beginnings. As we began the new millennium, we could look back at successes as well as losses, and we are thankful as well as positive and hopeful. We fully expect our new contract will be approved by Adelphia Cable Corporation, and anticipate the resulting opportunities for channel expansion and improved television services for Colchester, Georgia, and Milton which the new contract will create.

Channel Director's

FY 98/99 held many challenges and triumphs for LCATV-Channel 2. One of the first challenges came when Lake Champlain Cable (the cable operator that carries Channel 2's signal) was purchased by Adelphia Cable Corporation. Adelphia owns more than 90 percent of the cable operating systems in Vermont and is the 5th largest cable company in the nation.

Soon after the sale, the LCATV staff and board began negotiating a new contract with Adelphia. As of the writing of this report a few issues remain unresolved but ultimately the new contract will be very positive for Channel 2. It calls for a large budget increase which will, among other things, allow for more coverage of municipal meetings, school events, and community issues and Channel 2 will be replacing old equipment that has been with the station since its inception. The contract also calls for an additional channel to be added to the system in January of 2001. The goal will be to dedicate this channel to governmental and educational programming. The new channel will ease the current time strain and allow for coverage of additional local meetings as well as carry more regional events. Adelphia has also agreed to install reverse feeds in the schools and municipal buildings. This will give Channel 2 the ability to broadcast live from those locations!

Channel 2 expanded in FY 98/99 and built a new broadcast studio. The new space allowed us to move our control room from a cramped hallway and to now have greater flexibility during live studio productions. The new studio was named in honor of longtime LCATV board member James F. McMullan, Jr. during the inaugural broadcast on Town Meeting Day 1999. Hank and Inge Schaefer were also honored during that broadcast as Channel 2 Volunteers of the Year.

Channel 2 received a couple of honors in the 1999 Alliance for Community Media Northeast Region video competition. Michelle Penca's *Vermont Gardens* won third place in the non-professional special interest category and *Story Time* won second place in the children's professional category.

I think a lot of great things are happening at Channel 2 and the staff looks forward to serving Colchester, Milton and Georgia even better in the year to come.
