EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S

Lake Champlain Access Television has entered the digital age. For years we have toiled away behind our sturdy, reliable S-VHS cameras and editors. And while they're not going anywhere for a while yet, Fiscal Year 2001/2002 saw the introduction of exciting new formats and equipment as we built a digital work center. We acquired three nonlinear editing systems (all Macintosh) and four digital camcorders (all Sony) and have produced several in-house projects in digital formats. While some producers have been reluctant to give up the familiarity of VHS, the younger set has flocked to it. During our video production classes



with Colchester High School, there is invariably a wait to use one of the editing computers. They hardly even look at the linear systems these days. And their work on this new technology is not going unnoticed. At the New England Scholastic Press Association Video Broadcasting Awards, representatives from the CHS video production class took home top honors in editing and best of show for. fittingly, a segment produced at LCATV about our digital equipment.

They weren't the only award winners among our ranks. In 2001, the whole of New England found out what we've known for some time now: that LCATV has the best community bulletin board around. Production Coordinator and resident graphics generating artist Buddy Meilleur placed first in the bulletin board category of the Alliance for Community Media's Annual Northeast Regional Video Festival. All told, it was an eventful October for Buddy. In addition to his award, Buddy also became LCATV's second fulltime employee at the start of the fiscal year. It was a logical and muchneeded progression for him and us.

The changes at LCATV extend to the cosmetic as well as the technological. A facility renovation continues, however slowly. I've spent many weekends (along with a few dedicated friends) inhaling paint fumes in the name of interior improvements. We now have ample videotape shelving...ending the days of piling box on top of box and the frustrating searches for the tape we needed. The old Channel 2 sign has a new resting place in our foyer. And most of the walls are as soothing a shade of blue as is probably safe if we want to continue to be productive. I hope in next year's report to write of the completion of these renovations. There goes my weekend.

Lots of personnel changes. In addition to promoting Buddy to fulltime, we saw the departure of Playback Programmer Patricia Braine and the arrival of Rebecca Padula (a former field producer and current station manager at Mount Mansfield Community TV) to the position. We lost some field producers and gained some more. And we welcomed Tim Hunt to the LCATV Board of Directors as our Milton Public Access Representative, finally giving us a full slate of Milton Board members.

Many changes and many improvements during FY 2001/2002 at LCATV. There's much more that could be mentioned. Like weeks of work by Buddy and I on the handsome new Field Producer's Handbook. But instead of listing all of last year's accomplishments, perhaps we'll concentrate on achieving the things that I'll get to write about this time next year.


