



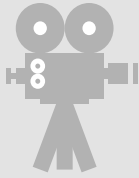

Comments from the public is an agenda item at our monthly Board of Directors meetings. You are welcome to attend these meetings. We are here to serve you!

We are having an Open House in a couple of months. Please drop in to meet our crew and observe demonstrations of our equipment. You might even see yourself in a monitor. Please check our community bulletin board as to date and times.

## EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The most difficult thing to accomplish this year may very well have been learning to answer the phone differently. Gone are the days of "Good morning, Channel 2." Indeed, gone is Channel 2. The fiscal year began with the completion of Adelpia's upgrades to the Lake Champlain cable system and the many changes it wrought. Digital cable and high-speed Internet access became available to us. For cable subscribers, there were more channels from which to choose (and higher rates to pay) and they were all in different places on the dial. And Channel 2 became the TV Guide Channel as we moved on up to 15. This was a minor adjustment, though, compared with what was to come.



In February, we welcomed the newest member of the LCATV family: Channel 16. The problem of trying to pack the long meetings in with the 20-odd public access shows and our exemplary community bulletin board was solved. Having separate channels for public access and for educational and government access allowed us the long-needed ability to provide our producers and viewers with more frequent and popular air times. It also provided us with more programming to oversee, more tape changes to accomplish and a second bulletin board to maintain. The staff has welcomed the new responsibilities, though, and recognizes this as an excellent way to better serve the LCATV membership. And we anxiously await the arrival of Channel 17 sometime in the future.

Even though we're taking up more space on the television dial, we seem to have less space in our Prim Road facility. For the first time in many years, we were able to purchase a variety of new equipment for the public and the staff to utilize. There were two new computers, a dandy video mixer and, perhaps the most welcome of these new tools, a second video editing suite. All have been getting more than their share of use and the results of having these items are visible in many subtle ways, like titles throughout meetings so you'll always know what you're watching and three-camera shoots in our studio (the old mixer could only handle two). The most exciting acquisitions, however, may well be the first of what we hope will become a whole workshop of digital equipment. We added a Power Mac G4 with Final Cut Pro editing software and a Sony PD-150 mini DV camcorder to our production arsenal this year and are well on the road to learning this new technology and sharing it with our membership. And we're excited about future purchases as we prepare to jump into the digital age.

In the midst of all this newness, we've also had a return to the past here at LCATV by working again with Colchester High School. With the cooperation of CHS faculty member John Coon, we hosted a semester-long video production class for a group of seniors during the fall of 2000. The students were able to learn much about our equipment and produce five episodes of an original series entitled *CHS Now* during their time here. Some are still putting their experience to use, working with such programs as *The Edge* and *Holy Cross Children's Mass*. We plan to welcome a new group of students during the Spring 2002 semester and, hopefully, every school year after that.


"New" was the word at Lake Champlain Access Television during fiscal year 2000/2001. New channels...new equipment...new staff (goodbye to Barnabas Rose and a welcome to Patricia Braine)...renewed relationships. And these changes show little sign of slowing in the upcoming months. And we look forward to them. While we might think back fondly to the days of "Good morning, Channel 2," we fully embrace the present and future of "Good morning, Lake Champlain Access."

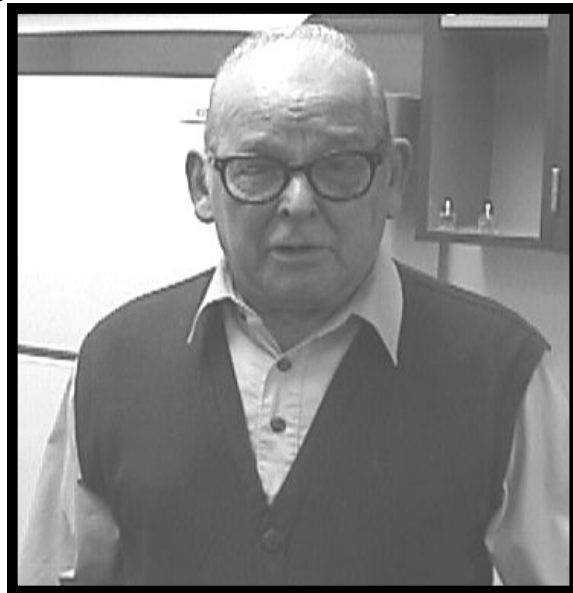
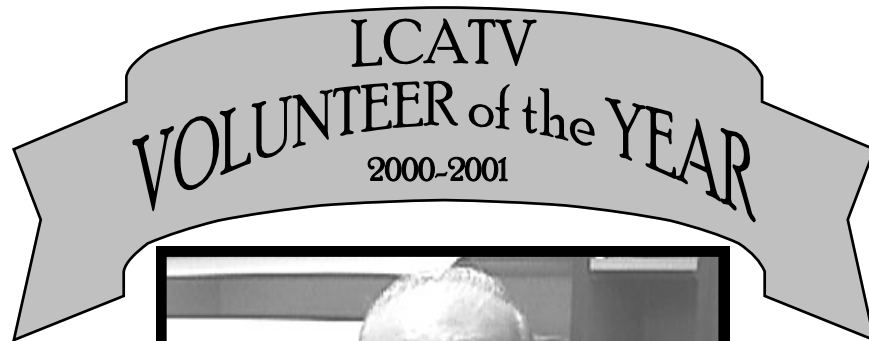
